

Registration Fees and Deposits (2011-2012)

A number of fee payments and deposits are required to register with the Toronto Swim Club for the 2011-2012 year as outlined below. The Club policies and payment options with respect to these can be found in the Fees Policies and Payment Policies downloads. The fees and deposits consist of **Registration Fees** (a combination of Swim Fees and a Fundraising portion), a deposit to the **Meet Fee Account**, an **SNC / SO Registration Fee** and a **Family Participation Deposit** .

1. REGISTRATION FEES:

The Registration Fees are a combination of swim fees and a fundraising portion. Swim fees cover pool rental, coaching fees and related costs. A portion of the registration fees is designated as the fundraising component, as this is the maximum amount that can be recouped through various fundraising programs throughout the year.

2. MEET FEE DEPOSIT: Swimmers are entered in meets during the swim year in accordance with their group and qualifying times. Each club hosting a meet charges entry fees. These meet fee costs are the responsibility of the swimmer's family and you will be charged in accordance with the entries specific to your swimmer. A meet fee deposit, specific to the group, is payable at registration to cover the cost of entry into swim meets attended throughout the year. Any positive balance in the meet fee account from the previous season will be rolled over and debited from the deposit required for the current swim season. Similarly, a small negative balance may have carried forward and be added to the deposit required for the current swim season. Both the **Registration Fees** and the **Meet Fee Deposit** are specific to the group in which the swimmer is registered, reflecting factors such as the number of practices and amount of time per practice per week, level of coaching and number of meets in which the swimmer is expected to participate. 3. SNC / SO REGISTRATION:

Swim Ontario requires that all members of a competitive swim club register with Swim Ontario at the beginning of each swim season. This fee, composed of fees for both Swimming Natation Canada and Swim Ontario, is payable in full at registration. These vary with the age of the swimmer (based on the swimmer's age as of Dec. 31, 2011).

4. FAMILY PARTICIPATION DEPOSIT:

The Club collects an initial **\$250 Family Participation Deposit** from each family (for all groups except Intro). This is intended to be a once only deposit, to be carried forward each year throughout a family's tenure with the Club, and is 100% refundable on graduation or withdrawal from the Club as long as the Family Participation requirements have been met each year. Failure to meet the minimum volunteer requirements during any season will result in the forfeiture of your participation deposit,

in which case **a new deposit of \$500** will be required prior to re-registration the following year.
